RESOLUTION OF MARCH 01, 2010

R-1-03-01-2010

RESOLUTION IN FULL SUPPORT OF PROTECTING AND PRESERVING THE GLEN COVE SHELLMOUND BURIAL SITE (AKA GLEN COVE WATERFRONT PARK) AS A SACRED SITE

- Whereas,** the California Valley Miwok Tribe is a sovereign self-governing Indian tribe recognized by the United States Government, and
- Whereas,** [Article VI, Section 1 (a)], of the Constitution of the California Valley Miwok Tribe invest in the Tribal Council the authority to negotiate and contract with agencies of the Federal, State, Local, Tribal Governments, private entities and individuals on behalf of the Tribe, and
- Whereas,** the Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the California Valley Miwok Tribe; and
- Whereas,** the California Valley Miwok Tribe is a federally recognized Tribe; and
- Whereas,** the California Valley Miwok Tribe has been and remains a supporter and advocate of Indigenous traditional, religious, civil and inherent sovereign rights; and
- Whereas,** the California Valley Miwok Tribe acknowledges the Glen Cove Shellmound Burial Site (aka Glen Cove Waterfront Park) as a sacred site that deserves/demands protection and respect; and

Whereas, the Greater Vallejo Recreation District (GVRD) and the City of Vallejo are currently purposing to develop a park with trails and amendments that would desecrate the Glen Cove Shellmound Burial Site; and

Whereas, the California Valley Miwok Tribe is in support of preserving this historic sacred site; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council of the California Valley Miwok Tribe acknowledges Glen Cove Shellmound Burial (aka Glen Cove Waterfront Park) a sacred site that deserves/demands protection and respect; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the California Valley Miwok Tribe is a federally recognized Tribe that fully supports preserving this historic sacred site.


CERTIFICATION


