## Proposal to Greater Vallejo Recreation District to Protect Glen Cove Sacred Site

April 5, 2011

We respectfully request that GVRD agree to leave the Glen Cove area and the sacred and culturally significant site to be protected and undisturbed:

- 1. No paved parking lot (there is already adequate parking)
- 2. No bathroom at or near the sacred site
- 3. No paving of hiking trails or construction of new trails
- 4. Protect the creeks
- 5. No grading or removal of part of the hill overlooking Glen Cove
- 6. No use of toxic herbicides
- 7. No tree removal unless tree is diseased and poses threat to other trees
- 8. Protection of endangered species
- 9. Human remains and artifacts removed from burials at Glen Cove must be returned and reburied at Glen Cove.
- 10. No lighting should be installed due to the interference with the spiritual well-being of the people buried at the site
- 11. No water fountains or picnic tables
- 12. No paved roads
- 13. No use of heavy equipment that will disturb and destroy the ancient village and burial site and artifacts
- 14. Protect the wetlands
- 15. Any planning to remove the Stremmel mansion and the other existing structures will be approved by SSP&RIT and done in the least impactful manner possible.
- 16. No additional construction of buildings or facilities.
